MARCH 2025 SUMMARY

For the month ended March 31st, 2025, the IDX Dynamic Innovation Fund (DYN) returned **-5.83%**. Allocations to small-capitalization new economy and artificial intelligence companies negatively impacted performance (AIQ: -6.89%; QQQ: -7.59%), while large-capitalization low-volatility stocks were the only positive contributor (SPLV: 0.41%).

The Fund has adopted a defensive positioning entering April. Allocations to innovative blockchain and small-capitalization new economy companies have been completely replaced with large-capitalization low volatility, quality, and consumer staples businesses.

We believe this repositioning uniquely positions the portfolio to outperform during the current period of heightened market volatility. A fundamental aspect of our innovation investment philosophy is employing tactical strategies that help preserve investor capital during periods of stress and volatility. As we navigate uncertainty, we remain committed to seeking positive expected risk/reward environments for innovation investments.

As rapid technological advancements create both winners and losers throughout the economy—within and beyond the technology sector—we believe investors need broad and efficient exposure to these transformative technologies.

Through disciplined execution, the IDX Dynamic Innovation Fund aims to provide investors with comprehensive exposure to innovation while strategically allocating capital only when risk-reward profiles are favorably skewed in our investors' favor.
